All entrants must pay a prelim entry of **£28** per team to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Prelim entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries [www.britishridingclubs.org.uk](http://www.britishridingclubs.org.uk) or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop [www.britishhorse.com](http://www.britishhorse.com) Late prelim entries may be accepted with a late surcharge of £20 per team at the discretion of the organiser if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed and must not be paid for unless approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be considered from the original close of prelim entry.

#### **Protective Headgear**

**'Protective Headwear' must be worn at all times by anyone, whether or not a Competitor, riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. At all BRC Championships and qualifiers 'Protective Headwear' must show a visible BRC 'hat tag'. 'Protective Headwear' constitutes a hat which meets one of the current standards as detailed**

- PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark 
- VG1 01.040 (2014-12) AND BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark
- ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) AND SEI mark
- SNELL E2001/2016 AND Official SNELL label and number
- AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) AND SAI Global mark

In the BRC 2018 Rule Book. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

BRC, BE and Pony Club have come together this year and settled on a single colour Hat Tag, this is the new Aqua coloured tag, once you are tagged by one discipline your hat will be good for the other 2 disciplines.

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

**British Riding Clubs and the Organiser of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. **Each Riding Club to appoint a Chef d'Equipe who is responsible for making declarations, collecting team numbers and being the point of contact throughout the day.**

**One helper per team, the details of whom MUST be sent with the team entry.**

**If there is a change over of helpers during the day it must be made clear to those people concerned that they do not under any circumstances abandon their post until the person who is taking over arrives and a proper hand over can be achieved.**

By the same token the organiser must be notified of the details of ALL helpers
